New Year





Hi! The Word on the Street session want to remind you all, that Chinese New Year is coming up on Tuesday 1st February.

We made some paper lanterns and have written a 'step-by-step' guide for you to use this in your sessions.

Step 1
Choose a piece of card.



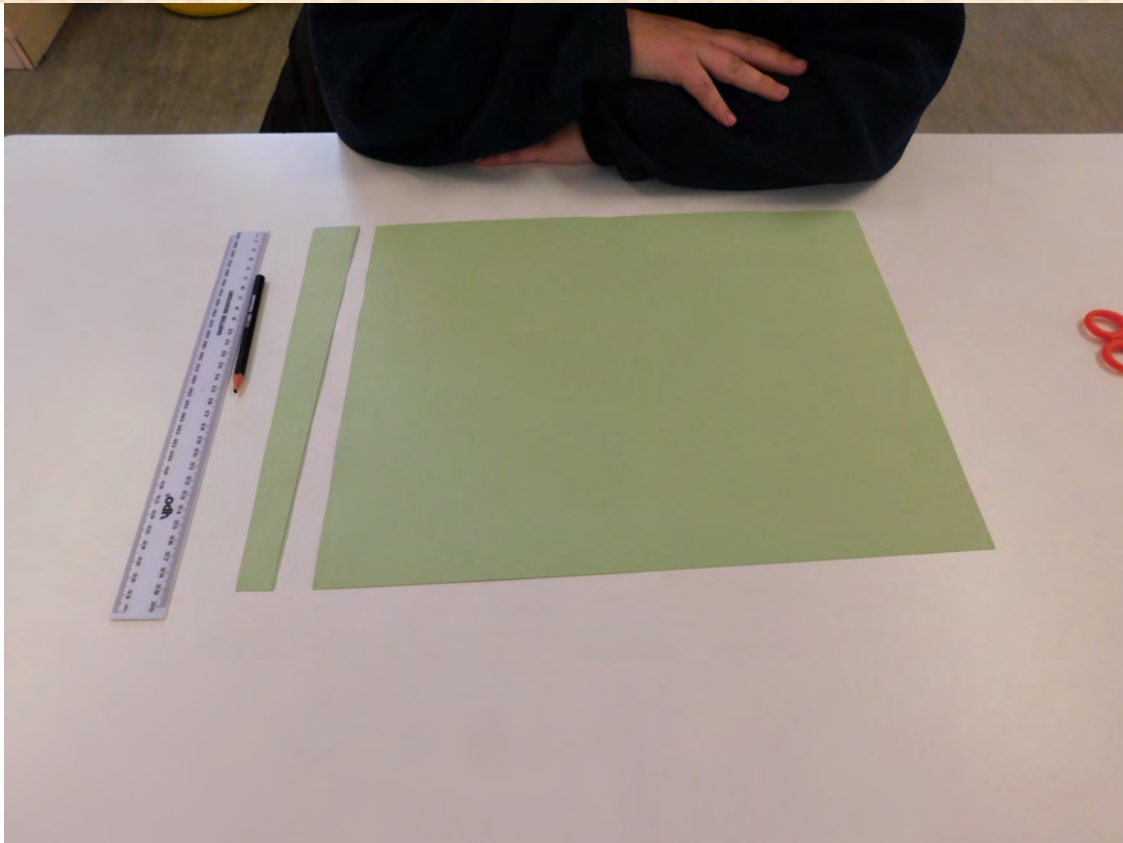
Step 2

Place it horizontally in front of you. Put the ruler along one edge of the paper, draw a line one ruler's width.



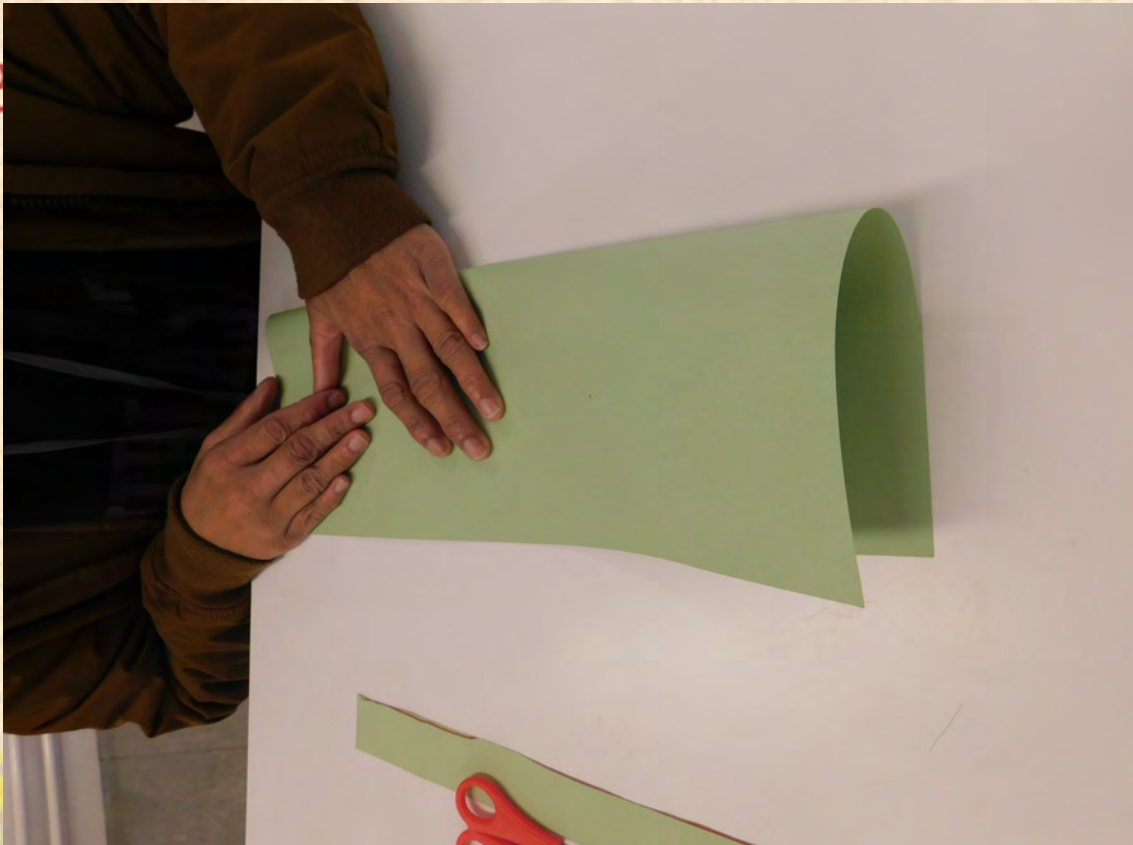
Step 3

Cut along the line. Set this strip of card aside as it will become the handle later.



Step 4

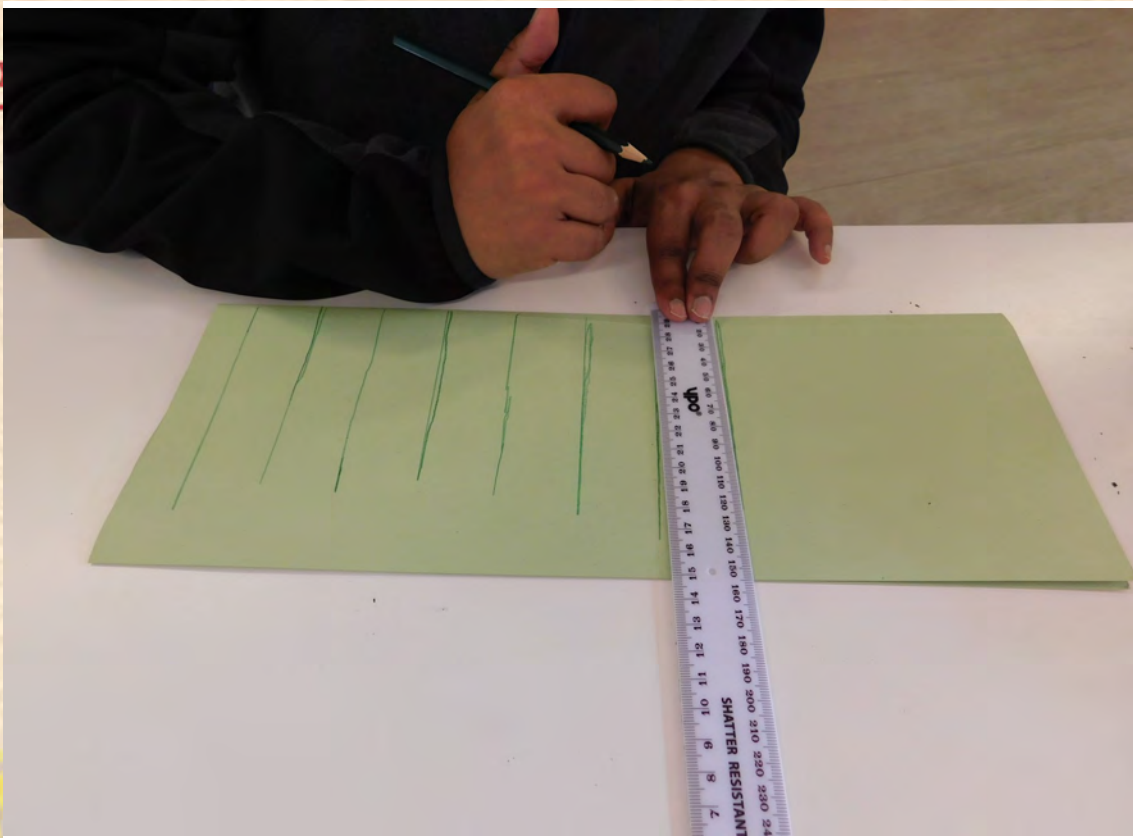
Fold the card horizontally so the long sides touch each other. With your fingers, press along the crease of the card.



Step 5

Turn the paper to be landscape in front of you, with the fold at the bottom. Place your ruler on the fold and draw a line (one ruler's width) from the fold to the top, making sure you leave a 2cm gap.

Repeat all the way along the card.



Step 6

Cut along the line, making sure you stop before cutting all the way through.



Step 7

Open up the card and decorate it if you want to. Curl it around and stick the edges together, using glue, tape or a stapler.



Step 8

Attach the handle to the top, again using glue, tape or a stapler.

Enjoy your
